What information we collect, use, and why

We collect or use the following information to **provide services and goods, including delivery**:

- Names and contact details

- Personal information used for administration of research

We collect or use the following information to **comply with legal requirements**:

Lawful bases

Our lawful bases for collecting or using personal information to **provide services** and goods are:

- Legitimate interest:
 - Allergy information to ensure products are correctly labelled to prevent harm to customer.

Where we get personal information from

• People directly

How long we keep information

We keep your personal contact information including name, address, email address and contact number for the duration of our interaction, i.e. initial enquiry until delivery.

Name, email and contact number will be retained for one year from end of previous interaction. This enables a smoother service for repeat customers.

All other information will be deleted at the end of our initial interaction.

If consent has been given, personal contact details will be added to the mailing list for future marketing purposes. You can request to be removed from this list at any point.

Your data protection rights

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

Your right of access - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal data.

Your right to rectification - You have the right to ask us to rectify personal data you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.

Your right to erasure - You have the right to ask us to erase your personal data in certain circumstances.

Your right to restriction of processing - You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances.

Your right to object to processing - You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances.

Your right to data portability - You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal data you gave us to another organisation, or to you, in certain circumstances.

Your right to withdraw consent – When we use consent as our lawful basis you have the right to withdraw your consent.

You don't usually need to pay a fee to exercise your rights. If you make a request, we have one calendar month to respond to you.

How to complain

If you have any concerns about our use of your personal data, you can make a complaint to us using the contact details at the top of this privacy notice.

If you remain unhappy with how we've used your data after raising a complaint with us, you can also complain to the ICO.
